- (b) Do not arise.
- (c) During the period 1995-96 to 1999-2000, 312 Foreign Investment Proposals in food processing sector were approved, envisaging Foreign Investment of Rs. 7044 Crore approximately. Actual implementation details for the five year period are not available. However, 114 projects were implemented during the period 1991 to Dec. 1999 with inflow of foreign investment of over Rs. 2299 crores.
- (d) Out of 114 projects implemented, 76 are Export Oriented Units.
 - (e)(i) Automtic approval for foreign equity up to 100% is available for most of the processed food items, subject to certain conditions.
 - (ii) Food Processing Industries have been included in the list of priority sector.
 - (iii) Most of the Processed food items have been exempted from the purview of licensing under Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951.
