the Canadian Minister of Justice and Attorney of Canada had stated in Parliament that according to availing information the Eagle Combat the Bodygaurd Training School was apparently providing self-defence and related training to the public it was operating under a Municipal license; there was no indication of any criminal offences being committed in connection with this school and it was doing nothing which was known to be in violation of the law Some additional information is awaited from the Canadian authorities.
