Will the Minister of EXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :

(a) whether Government are aware that new mercenary training school have been opened in Canada where extremists are getting training in guerilla war fare tactics ;

(b) whether Government have received any information from the High Commission in Canada that Six militants from Toronto, New York and other US cities are receiving training in those schools; and

(c) whether the Government of India ave protested to the Canadian Government in the matter and if so, with what results ?

THE MINISTER OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI B. R. BHAGAT):

(a) The Government is aware of the existence of the "Eagle Combat and Bodyguard Training School" in New Westminster, British Columbia, Canada.

(b) Government had received information from the High Commission of India, Canada, that 10 Sikh Youths, believed to be residents of Canada, were given training in the School.

(c) The Government of India drew the Canadian Government's attention to the reports about the training that the sikh Youths had received in the Eagle Combat and Bodyguard Training School and requested urgent investigations, sharing of information and corrective action as appropriate. On 4th November 1985,

the Canadian Minister of Justice and Attorney of Canada had stated in Parliament that according to availing information the Eagle Combat the Bodyguard Training School was apparently providing self defence and related training to the public it was operating under a Municipal license; there was no indication of any criminal offences being committed in connection with this school and it was doing nothing which was known to be in violation of the law. Some additional information is awaited from the Canadian authorities.
