(a) whether the levy prices for paddy and other foodgrains for the current agricultural season have been announced; and

(b) if so, what are the details in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND CO-OPERATION (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) and (b) Only rice is procured under levy system. Procurement prices of levy rice fixed for 1985-86 marketing

season for different States are given as under:

Irrigation schemes pending in Vidarbha areas of Maharashtra

768. SHRI S.W. DHABE:
SHRI ASHWANI KUMAR:

Will the Minister of WATER RESOURCES be pleased to state:

(a) what is the water potential available for irrigation in Vidarbha area of Maharashtra;

(b) what is the number of major Irrigation schemes which are pending completion in that area; and

(c) what are the reasons therefor and by when these are likely to be completed and at what cost?

THE MINISTER OF WATER RESOURCES (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND):

(a) Water potential of areas within a State is not maintained.

(b) 13 major irrigation projects are pending completion.

(c) The reasons for non-completion of projects include constraints of financial resources, proliferation of projects, inadequate investigations, escalation of costs and scarcity of construction materials. Four projects viz., Pench Irrigation, Kalisaras, Lower Wunna and Arunavati are likely to be completed during the Seventh Plan and the balance would be completed in subsequent plans.
