Andhra Pradesh request for assistance to curb Naxalites

1270. SHRI B. KRISHNA MOHAN: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Andhra Pradesh Government has sought assistance to curb Naxalities;
- (b) what steps Government have taken in this regard; and
- (c) whether any assistance has been extended to the Andhra Pradesh Government in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERNAL SECURITY (SHRI ARUN NEHRU): (a) to (c) Yes, Sir. Government of Andhra Pradesh had sought assistance for deployment of 4 battalions of CRPF. Taking into account the present overall deployment of the CRPF and in particular the requirements in connection with elections in Assam it was no found possible to place any Force at the disposal of the State Government. They were however advised to seek additional police from the neighbourng States.

Bank officers on deputation to the CBI

1271. SHRIMATI USHA MALHOT-RA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state;

- (a) whether bank officers are being taken on deputation to the C.B.I.; and

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATIVE REFORMS AND PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND SION (SHRI P. HIDAMBARAM): (a) and (b) Central Bureau of Investigation has a post of Technical Officer (Banking) to be filled up by a suitable Bank Officer on deputation. However, there is considerable difficulty in securing the services of a bank officer with sufficient experience to fill this post. Hence CBI, have obtained the services of an officer of State Bank of India on loan basis to assist in investigation of bank fraud cases.

Re-employment of retired defence personnel n police force

1272. SHRIMATI USHA MALHOT-RA: Will the Minister of HOME AF-FAIRS be pleased to state whether Government propose to re-employ Somnel, in various Police forces in equivalent ranks on which they retired without a break in service?

- (c) Under the bye-laws the General Body of the Society shall elect 8 Directors every two years among them, who shall hold office for a period of two years commencing from 1st July, next. The election of the 8 existing Directors was conducted by the General Body on 25-10-83 and their term came to an end on 30-6-85. The Board of Directors in its meeting held on 21-11-85 have decided to hold elections of 8 Directors on the 30th December, 1985.
