THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI VIR SEN): (a) No, Sir.

U.N. General Assembly Resolution on Conference on Indian Ocean

1009. SHRI K. MOHANAN: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the U.N. General Assembly passed a resolution recently recommending a conference on Indian Ocean to be held not later than the first half of next year; and

(b) if so, what steps Government have taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI KHURSHID ALAM KHAN): (a) The U.N. General Assembly on 17th December 1984 adopted a resolution which, *inter alia*, requested the Ad-hoc Committee on the

Indian Ocean to complete preparatory work to enable the opening of the Conference on the Indian Ocean at Colombo at the earliest date in the first half of 1986 to be decided by the Committee in consultation with the host country.

(b) The Government of India have been working actively in the Ad-hoc Committee on the Indian Ocean during its sessions in 1985 to ensure that preparations are complete in order to enable the holding of the Conference in time.

Preaching of separation by extremists in the Western countries

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI KHURSHID ALAM KHAN): (a) and (b) All our Missions abroad where Air India operates have been instructed to secure assistance from local authorities to help Air India augment the security arrangements for Air India flights. The responses have been positive.
