After verification and site inspection these six application were rejected by the Factory Licensing Department of the Municipal Corporation of Delhi.

During 1984-85, however, the following schemes were taken up by the Department for the development and promotion of tourism in Jammu and Kashmir which are at various stages of implementation; 810 RS-2

- 1. Development of facilities at Bagh-i-Bahu (Jammu) 7.75
- 2. Construction of Indian Institute of Skiing and Mountainneering building, Gulmarg 20,00
- 3. Import of ski euipment through State Trading Corporation for IIS&M, Gulmarg. 3.21
- 4. Purchase of trekking and mountaineering equipment for use by the State Department of Tourism 2.05

During the VII Five Year Plan, the Department proposes to take development of schemes at Awantipur, Martand and Pandrathan for which Master Plans (landuse plan) have been prepared. The details of the schemes to be taken up in the Central sector are awaited from the State Government. In addition, the Department has also agreed to provide way side facilities on the Leh-Srinagar road and some accommodation at Leh for which again specific proposals are awaited from the State Government.
