(c) Government has not received any application for employment of another German national in German Remedies.

(d) and (e) Question does not arise in view of (c) above.

(f) Approvals to the appointments of expatriate directors are given, keeping in mind various factors like foreign equity, terms of collaboration agreements, nature of concerned industry, Articles of Association of the Company, need for technical know-how, etc.

In regard to appointments of technicians, expatriates are considered only when it is essential and relevant technical skills are not adequately available in India. Further, compliance with the provisions of FERA, 1973 is also ensured in their case.

#### **Drug to be specified in Drug Price Control Order, 1979**

2325. SHRI SHANKARRAO NARAYANRAO DESHMUKH: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 1346 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 6th August, 1984 and state:

(a) the names of the drugs which are still to be specified in the Drugs Price Control Order, 1979;

(b) the names of the manufacturers of these drugs and production of each during the last three years, year-wise;

(c) whether the prices of formulations based on these drugs and production of each during the last three years, year-wise;

(d) if so, when and what price of each pack, strength of each formulation was fixed.

(e) what was the price of bulk drug taken into account while working the price of each formulation;

(f) by when these drugs including Fenbendazole will be specified in Price Control Orders; and

(g) what are the names of the drugs specified after the inception of Drugs Price Control Order?

#### **Import of Oxytocin Powder**

2326. SHRI SHANKARRAO NARAYANRAO DESHMUKH: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to refer to the answer to Unstarred Question 2020 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 13th August, 1984 and state:

(a) what was the import of each of Oxytocin Powder by Hano Pharma, Sandoz and Park Davis during the last three years, year-wise along with source of import and CIF price per kg. per consignment;

(b) what is the estimated requirement of this drug during 1985-86 and what was the production of Hemo Pharma and other units during the last three years, year-wise;

(c) what is the price fixed by Government of this drug;

(d) what are the names of the formulators of this drug and what is the consumption and procurement by each during the last three years, year-wise along with the name of source of procurement; and

(e) what are the names of formulations of each and the price fixed for each pack, strength of each formulation and what price of bulk drug was taken in each case?

THE MINISTER OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) to (e) Information to the extent available would be collected and laid on the Table of the Rajya Sabha.

**Secretaries panel to vet new drug policy**

2327. SHRI HAYAT ULLA ANSARI: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news items captioned 'Secretaries panel to vet new drug policy' which appeared in *Business Standard* of 16th July, 1985;

(b) if so, whether it is a fact that his Ministry is submitting a position paper on proposed policy to the committee secretaries based on NDPDC's report in spite of the fact that there was criticism of report by consultative Committee and experts group;

(c) whether it is a fact that his Ministry has already announced 50 per cent of the policy by delicensing 94 per cent of the policy by delicensing 94 bulk drugs;

(d) what were the basis of announcing delicensing policy when NDPDC's report is under examination;

(e) whether it is also a fact that Government are reconsidering the decision about delicensing; and

(f) if so, by when the outcome will be known?

THE MINISTER OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEERENDRA PATIL): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) Government would take a decision on the changes/modifications needed in the Drug Policy keeping in view all the relevant factors and various view points.

(c) and (d) Government issued a press note on 16th March, 1985 delicensing 12 bulk drugs and intermediates for non-FERA and non-MRTP companies. 82 additional bulk drugs were

further delicensed on 5th June, 1985. Delicensing was done to simplify the licensing procedure and does not depart in any way from the parameters of 1978 Policy.

(c) what was the quantity of Erythromycin and its salts was procured by Abbott during the last three years, year-wise alongwith source and price per kg. of procurement of each purchase;

(d) what are the names of the formulation being manufactured and marketed by this company based on this drug; and

(e) what is the sales turnover of Erythromycin and its salts formulations of this company during the last three years, year-wise and what is the percentage to total sale?
