

Appointment of Judges from Tribal Communities

2299. SHRI RAMSINGBHAI PATA. LIYABHAI RATHVAKOLI: Will the Minister of LAW AND JUSTICE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that due representation has not been given to Tribal Communities in the appointments of Magistrates and Judges in various States and in the Supreme Court;

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(c) how many magistrates and Judges belonging to Tribal Communities are there at present in various States?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF LAW AND JUSTICE (SHRI H. R. BHARDWAJ): (a) to (c) The appointment of District Judges and of persons other than District Judges to the State Judicial Services is made by the State Governments. The requisite information is being called for from them and will be laid on the Table of the House.

Appointment of Judges to the High Courts and Supreme Court is made by the President under relevant provisions of the Constitution which do not provide for reservation for any caste, community, etc. There was one

Judge belonging to Scheduled Tribe in the Bombay High Court as on 1-4-1985, and none in the Supreme Court.
