THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (c) The primary health centres are being established for every 30,000 rural population. This norm has been relaxed for tribal/hilly areas as one PHC for every 20,000 population. It is proposed to open 50 primary health centres in Madhya Pradesh during 1985-86. As the establishment of Primary Health Centres is under the State Sector Minimum Needs Programme, their location is decided by the respective State Governments.
