THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARUN NEHRU): (a) In May, 1985, the World Bank has approved a loan of US \$ 250 million for construction of transmission lines associated with Rihand Super Thermal Power Project.

(b) The constituents of Northern Region will benefit with the completion of this transmission system.

Criteria or opening of Primary Health Centres

2578. SHRIMATI RATAN KUMARI: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) what are the criteria adopted for opening of primary health centres;

(b) whether any priority is given to tribal and backward areas; and

(c) the number of primary health centres proposed to be opened in Madhya Pradesh in near future and locations selected for the purpose?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) to (c) The primary health centres are being established for every 30,000 rural population. This norm has been relaxed for tribal/hilly areas as one PHC for every 20,000 population. It is proposed to open 50 primary health centres in Madhya Pradesh during 1985-86. As the establishment of Primary Health Centres is under the State Sector Minimum Needs Programme, their location is decided by the respective State Governments.

Rural Electrification Programme in Orissa

2579. SHRI JAGADISH JANI: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

(a) the amount spent by the Rural Electrification Corporation in implementing the rural electrification programme in Orissa during the Sixth Five Year Plan period;

(b) the target set for Orissa during the above period and the achievements made this regard; and

(c) the number of villages in Orissa proposed to be brought under the Seventh Five Year Plan period?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARUN NEHRU): (a) The Rural Electrification Corporation (REC) disbursed an amount of Rs. 55.57 crores as loan assistance to the Orissa State Electricity Board for implementation of the Rural Electrification programme during the Sixth Plan.

(b) 6531 villages were electrified against a target of 6835 villages; 17,044 pumpsets were energized against a target of 39,680 pumpsets.

(c) It is, tentatively, proposed to electrify 7558 villages in Orissa during the Seventh Plan.

Selection of Schools in Gujarat under Education through T.V. Programme

2580. SHRI RAMSINGBHAI PATA-LIYABHAI RATHVAKOLI: Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether some schools have been selected or are likely to be selected in Gujarat for the programme of "Education through T.V.";

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) what is the number of tribal schools selected out of it; and

(d) the number of tribal areas to be covered under the programme?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) and (b) Under the INSAT for Education Scheme, 400 VHF TV sets and 300 Direct Reception sets are to be deployed in the three district clusters of Jamnagar, Junagadh and Rajkot by December, 1985. Out of these, 284 VHF sets and 14 Direct Reception sets have been deployed in the schools upto 31st July, 1985.

Working Women's Hostels in Delhi

(a) whether Delhi Administration had conducted any survey in the recent past on the accommodation problem of unmarried single women in Delhi;

(b) if so the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(c) what is the number of working women hostels at present being managed by the Delhi Administration/Central Government/private organisations in Delhi;

(d) what is the total capacity of each such hostel and the number of their inmates;

(e) whether a working women hostel at Saket is under construction since long; and

(e) if so, what is the numbers of working women hostels proposed to be set up during the Seventh Plan in Delhi?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL AND WOMEN'S WELFARE (SHRIMATI MARAGATHAM CHANDRASEKHAR):

(a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) Working Women's Hostels are not managed by the Delhi Administration/Central Government. Voluntary Organisations, which have been assisted by the Government for the construction of buildings for Working Women's Hostels, are running 6 Hostels in Delhi.
