Vacancies have occurred due to tion resignations, retirements, termination, etc. from time to time,
- (c) Ten vacancies of Progress (Engineering) remained to be filled at the end of 1984. These posts have been filled in 1985.
- (d) Waiting lists have been for each category and the selected candidates are sent offers of appointments as and when the vacancies occur.
