Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(a) whether any film of South African origin was shown/exhibited in India during the last three years;

(b) if so, what are the names of the films, cities and States where these were exhibited;

(c) whether any enquiry has been conducted to find out the circumstances under which these films were allowed into India;

(d) if so, what are the details of the enquiry, and action taken thereon, and

(e) if the answer to part (c) above be in the negative, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V. N. GADGIL): (a) to (e) No, Sir. However, there are allegations that the films 'GODS MUST BE CRAZY' and 'BEAUTIFUL PEOPLE' which are being 'have been exhibited in India had been produced in South Africa. These films were certified by the Central Board of films Certification in 1972 and 1979 respectively. The applicants of these films have indicated that these films were produced in British West Indies and United States of America respectively. The Questions whether these two films were, in fact, produced in South Africa and if so, how the import was allowed in India are being examined in consultation with the concerned authorities. An en-

quiry under section 6 of the Cinematograph Act 1952 has been initiated in respect of these films. Notices have been issued to the applicants asking them to show-cause why the films should not be de-certified.
