A dual pricing system for kerosene which envisaged sale of 70 per cent of the quantity of kerosene allocated to each State/ Union Territory at subsidised price for distribution to weaker and vulnerable sections of society and the balance 30 per cent at non-subsidised price to others, which was introduced with effect from the 15th February, 1983, and was withdrawn with effect from the 18th March, 1983, as the State Governments/Union Terriexperienced Administrations difficulties in implementing it.
