THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRIES OF EDUCATION AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WEL-FARE (SHRIMATI SHEILA KAUL): (a) to (c) There are 84 engineering institutions in the country which offer post-graduate courses in Engineering and Technology. No seats are allotted to any State for admission which open to students from al over the country.

A proposal of Government of Kerala for starting a post-graduate course in an institution in Kerala with an intake of 6 students has been received. This proposal has been seen by the Screening Committee of the Board of Post-Graduate Studies and will now be considered first by the Board and thereafter by the Government of India.
