Prices for exports of steel are generally kept below the levels at which identical categories are sold in the domestic market. While the domestic prices in India include levies like Excise Duty, Contribution to Engineering Goods Export Assistance Fund, Steel Development Fund and Equalised Railway Freight element and JPC Cess; published international f.o.b. prices do not include ocean freight; handling, clearing and other port charges; import duties and inland transport cost which the consumer has to bear in case of imported steel.

#### Visit of the Senegal President to India

(a) whether the Senegalese President visited India during the 1st week of July, 1984; and

(b) if so, the nature of talks held with him and the outcome thereof?

The Senegalese President's desire to have increased cooperation in various fields, including economic and cultural, between the two countries, was fully reciprocated by our President and the P.M.

**Collection of funds by Hardayal Singh, self-styled Governor General of Khalistan**

1780. SHRI <sup>1</sup> MUKHTIAR SINGH MALIK: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news item which appeared in the 'Telegraph' (Calcutta) on 23rd June, 1984 to the effect that Hardayal Singh, the self-styled Governor General of Khalistan went to California to collect money in support of himself and for eight other Sikh extremists;

(b) if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) what action Government have taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI RAM NIWAS MIRDHA): (a) to (c) Government have seen the news item in question which has been circulated by Los Angeles Times—Washington Post News Service. Government are aware of the pro-Khalistan activities of some individuals abroad but the name of Hardayal Singh has not come to notice as one of the leaders. Government have been countering the extremists' propaganda abroad by maintaining contacts with the Press and providing audio and video cassettes to the ethnic media, Indian Associations, prominent individuals etc.

गृह मंत्रालय में राज्य मंत्री (श्रीमती राम बुलारी सिन्हा) : (क) 1 जनवरी, 1983 से 31 मार्च, 1983 के बीच राजभाषा विभाग द्वारा 49 कार्यालयों का निरीक्षण किया गया।

(ख) 1 अप्रैल से 30 जून, 1983 के बीच 112 कार्यालयों का निरीक्षण किया गया।

(ग) 1 जुलाई से 30 सितम्बर, 1983 के बीच 67 कार्यालयों का निरीक्षण किया गया।

(घ) जिन कार्यालयों का निरीक्षण किया जाता है उनकी तिमाही रिपोर्ट की समीक्षा की जाती है और जो कमियाँ होती हैं उनके बारे में निरीक्षण के साथ बतला दिया जाता है। कार्यालयों का तुलनात्मक विवरण रखने की कोई प्रथा नहीं है।
