Development ol Urdu Language

THE DEPUTY MINISTER JN THF. **EDUCATION** MINISTRIES OP AND CULTURE AND SOCIAL WELFARE (SHR P, K. THUNGON).- (a) The st«ps taken by the Government for the development of Urdu during the test 3 years included bringing out 169 tit!es including children's literature textbooks, supplementary readers under •various programmes of the Bureau for Promotion of Urdu. 1\$ calligraphy training centres were set up in various parts of the country. Projects of compilation of bibliography of Urdu books and Urdu-English, dictionary were Projects, of Urdu-Urdu dictionary and Students Urdu-Urdu dictionary have completed. About 50,000 technical terms have been finalise^ in various disciplines and 5 glossaries pertaining to chemistry, economics, anthropology, zoology and political science have been brought out. About 10 exhibitions and book fair, including World Book Fair were organised. Urdu books worth Rs. 8.20.332.17 hava been sold. Under the scheme of ftmincM assistance to voluntary organisations for promotion of Indian languages, 113 Urdu titles worth Rs. 4,13,993 were purchased from Urdu writers. Rs. 14,495 on publication of Urdu titles and Rs. 85,379'- x>n Urdu Seminars/Musbara arid Rs. 88.300 for teaching of Urdu language, were sanctioned to voluntary organisation. Besides steps were taken to implement recommendations of the Gujarat Committee in consultation with the State Govt, and on tbe advice of Taragi-e-Urdu Bo'ard.

(b) On gorng programmes will continue in the current financial year. The Government has already undertaken to start correspondence courses in Urdu through the medium of EogbshiHindi. A half yearly research journal will be startted. Compilation of French-Urdu and Urdu French dictionaries, an etymological dictionary of Turkish-Urdu, three calligraphy training centres acid Urdu adult education centres are proposed to be started.
