THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF IRRIGATION (SHRI HARI NATH MISHRA): (a) There is no general proposal for solving the problem of financing of the Inter-State multipurpose river valley projects.

(b) A Statement showing major irriga-

tion and multipurpose Inter-State river valley projects under construction more than 15 years is enclosed (*see below*).

(c) Modified Gadgil formula for allocating Central assistance to State Plans during the 6th Plan was approved by National Development Council (NDC) in its meeting held in August 1980. No proposal for further modification of the formula is under consideration at present.

(b) whether it is also a fact that after installation of thermal plant at Ropar the

rail link between Chandigarh and Morinda has been agreed to by the Railway Board; and

(c) whether it is also proposed to link Morinda with Ludhiana after Chandigarh and Morinda are linked by rail?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI AB. A GHANI KHAN CHOWDHURY): (a) Yes, Sir.

(c) Due to severe constraint of resources, at present there is no proposal to take up the construction of rail lines between Chandigarh and Morinda, and between Morinda and Ludhiana.

रेल मंत्री (श्री ए० बी० ए० गनोखान चौधरी) : (क) वर्ष 1982 में स्थायी वार्ता संघ के अघोषित मंडल/कारखाना और क्षेत्रीय मुख्यालय स्तर पर पूर्व रेलवे के साथ आयोजित अपनी बैठकों में मान्यता प्राप्त ट्रेड यूनियनों द्वारा 1,874 मुद्दे उठाये गये थे। इनमें से 1301 मुद्दों के संबंध में निर्णय लिया गया था और कार्यान्वित किया गया था।

वर्ष 1983 के संबंध में सूचना तत्काल उपलब्ध नहीं है।

(ख) 1982 और 1983 के दौरान पूर्व रेलवे के कर्मचारियों द्वारा विभिन्न न्यायालयों में लगभग 1,500 मामलों दायर किये गये थे। इनमें से अधिकांश मामलों सेवा मामलों से संबंधित हैं।

(e) whether history sheets of malaria patients are being maintained in Delhi hospitals and dispensaries; if not, the reasons therefor; and

(f) whether Government propose to conduct a probe into the allegations against malaria eradication and detection work in Delhi; if not, the reasons therefor?

During the last three years the incidence of malaria in Delhi, as per the available information, has been on the decline. 62415, 46530 and 42107 cases of malaria were reported during 1981, 1982 and 1983 respectively.
