#### **Repatriation of Workers from Bahrain**

2757. SHRI CHATURANAN MISHRA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are aware of the fact that large number of drivers and operators of earthmovers and other heavy machines were recently repatriated from Bahrain;

(c) whether it is a fact that these workers had protested against "appalling" living conditions in the labour camps there; and

(d) whether any enquiry has since been instituted into this matter?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI A. A. RAHIM): (a) Yes, Sir. A number of drivers and operators of earthmovers and other heavy machines were recently repatriated from Bahrain.

(b) Out of a total of 44 drivers engaged in a dispute with their employers, 28 have been repatriated voluntarily while 16 had decided to stay on.

(e) Yes, Sir.

(d) On the appearance of a newspaper report in Bahrain on the 26th

July, 1984 of a dispute between <"> workers and their local employers concerning non-payment of wages and unsatisfactory living conditions, officials from our Mission in Bahrain visited the camp site the same day. The Mission officials discussed with the employers the problems of the workers and again visited the camp to review the improvements being effected by the company in regard to the living condition in the camp. Our Mission in Bahrain is in regular touch with the management of the company in this regard. Arrangements for regular water supply have already been made and electrical connection, for which cables have been laid was expected shortly. The matter is also being taken up by our Mission with the local Labour Ministry.

#### **Violation of Territorial Waters by U. S. Navy**
