THE MINISTER OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VASANT SATHE). (a) and (b) M/s German Remidies hold DGTD registration granted in July, 1966 and industrial expansion granted in April 1973 for manufacture of Complamina tablets, which are based in bulk . Xantinol Nicotinate. Compiamina retard is the name given to tablets of strength of the same bulk drug. Complamina retard tablets is coverd under Industrial Licence No. IL: S 21(77) dated 1st February, 1977 within the composite capacity of 1335 lakhs per annum. Its capacity has been re-endorsed corresponding to the bulk drug requirement of 9988.15 kgs. per annum under the Policy of re-endorsement of capacity of April 1982.

(c) According to the company, the original value of the bulk drug plant was Rs. 6.95 lakhs. The value as on 31st December, 1983 was 78.83 lakh rupees. Similar 796 RS---8
