(b) No, Sir. Out of a total of 18 cases, in 7 cases dependents have already been approved for appointment on compassionate grounds; one case has been rejected; in one case dependent is minor; in two cases applications for compassionate appointment are yet to be received and seven cases are at various stages of processes and efforts are being to finalise them as early as possible.

(c) and (d) There has been no violation of existing orders. Various formalities have to be complied with before finalizing such cases which generally take time. It may also be mentioned that the appointment of dependents of a deceased Government employee is to be decided on merits of each case.

## TV centres in Gujarat

AFFAIRS (SHRI H. K. L. BHAGAT): (a) In addition to TV centres at Ahmedabad and Pij already operational and low power transmitters at Vadodra and Surat recently commissioned, two High Power Transmitters at Rajkot and Dwarka and four Low Power TV Transmitters at Bhruch, Bhavnagar, Navasari and Patan are scheduled to be commissioned in the State of Gujarat during 1984-85. The power of the TV transmitter at Ahmedabad will also be raised to 10 KW during the current year.
