(viii) Introduction of new systems with improved facilities and sophisticated equipment to enable quicker passenger clearance through security customs, immigration, etc.;

(ix) Computerisation of ticketing and reservation system;

(x) Introduction of regular roundthe-clock ushers'/"May I help you" service at the four international airports to provide 'on the spot' assistance to passengers; and

(xi) Construction of modern terminal building and banning the entry of visitors to the Arrival Lounge and other facilitation areas, to alleviate congestion at important airports.

These facilitation measures are constantly reviewed by Committees at various levels to bring about co-ordinated improvement in the standards of efficiency, courtesy and discipline.

## Textile mills run by the National Textile Corporation

\*126. SHRI HUSEN DALWAI: Will the Minister of COMMERCE be pleased to state:

(a) what is the number of textile mills (State-wise) at present run by the National Textile Corporation;

(b) how many bales of finished textiles were lying in the National Textile Corporation godowns (mill-wise) on the 31st December, 1983 and 31st March, 1984 and their respective values:

(c) whether it is a fact that the National Textile Corporation mills often go in for distress sale below cost price in order to reduce the inventories:

(d) what are the losses incurred by each mill under the National Textile Corporation during the period 1st January, 1983 and 31st March, 1984 by sale of Janta cloth and other varieties; (e) whether it is also a fact that the National Textile Corporation mills produce textile materials without first ascertaining the market demand; and

(f) whether the National Textile Corporation have done any market research arrangement to study market demand first and then produce such materials which are readily saleable so that there is no loss and there is no unsold inventory?

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE (SHRI P. A. SANGMA): (a) There are 103 nationalised textile mills under NTC, out of which 101 are in production. State-wise break-up of these 101 mills is given in the enclosed Statement I (See below).

In addition, there are 22 taken-over mills, which are at present being run  $b_y$  NTC.

(b) According to available information, a Statement showing the quantity of yarn and cloth in the NTC mills as on 31st December, 1983 and 31st March 1984 with their respective values is attached. [See Appendix CXXXI, Annexure No. 21].

(c) No, Sir. However, sales of noncontrolled cloth are made on prevailing market prices, which are in most cases lower than the cost price.

(d) The mill-wise profit/loss of NTC mills for the years 1982-83 and 1983-84 is given in enclosed Statement II (See below)

(e) and (f) No, Sir. The major part of NTC's production relates to controlled cloth, supplies to Government departments and export orders, which is in conformity with exact demands. In regard to the remaining production it is produced in consultation with agents/dealers, who are appointed throughout the country and are fully conversant with the demand at any particular time of the year. However, separate market research has not been undertaken so far.
