(b) what is the strength $_0f$ the reporting staff at the Lucknow T. V. Centre and whether any regular arrangements have been mad_e for coverage of proceedings of th State Legislature; and

(c) whether the local bulletin telecast by the Lucknow T. V. centre totally regional in character; if so, whether adequate attention is paid to the local news ary State's dev»lopment activities and other important developments?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V. N. GAD GIL): (a) News bulletins put out by Doordarshan Kendras are governed by guidelines to ensure accuracy, objectivity, impartiality and balanced representation to the activities of all parties, groups as well as events.

DoordarsYian Kendras have been instructed to send copies of their bulletins to the Head quarters to monitor the quality of the bulletins.

(b) Doordarshan Kendra, Lucknow has only one Reporter. The proceedings of the State Legislature are covered mostly from News. Agency copies. However, in special cases, a News Editor or an Assistant News Editor also attends the proceedings of the Legislature for reporting on important issues.

(c) The news bulletins put out by Doordarshan Kendra, Lucknow carries major national and international items but gives special emphasis on the news emanating from the State and the region regarding developmental activities and other important events.

Working of D.A.V.P. Regional Centre at Lucknow

383. SHRI KAPIL VERMA: Will the Minister of INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING be pleased to state:

(b) The Centre had $_{a}$ target of producing 1000 exhibition kits annually. This target could not however, b_{e} achieved on account of certain operation ,1 difficulties.

(c) The total expenditure incurred on the establishment of the Centre during 1982-8?, 1983-84 and 198-1-85 was Rs. 4,64,000, Rs. 3.46,700 and Rg.4,30400

Transfer Policy of Officers of Central Information Service

(a) what is the transfer policy in regard to Central Information Service Officers; and

(b) the number of CIS Officers who have been posted in the sam_c media unit for more than six years and th_c same \blacksquare station for mor_e than ten years.'

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V.N. GADGIL): (a) The guidelines relating to transfer and posting of officers of Central information Service are contained in the attached statement.

(b) Whereas 178 officers °f the Service hav_e completed over 6 years in th_e same Media Unit. 160 officers hav_e remained posted at the sam_e station for more than 10 pears.

Statement

Guidelines relating to transfer and pasting of officers of CIS

1. Transfer of officers should be governed by a careful career management Policy. Officers appointed to Grade-IV, Grade-11 and Grade-Ill either on direct recruitment basis or on promotion should ordinarily be required to complete six years in a media unit. Direct recruits to these grades should preferably be exposed to the experience of work in two media units one of which should be the information side of the news side-Officers belonging to Grade-I and above would be required to complete a period of ftv_a veins in a media unit befor_e transfer. While transferring officer^ in Grade-1. efforts should be made to consult the Media Head,

2. Whenever transfer of an officer from one place to another becomes necessary for filling vacancies in various grades, officers below 55 years of age will he transferred in the order of their length ->f stay in a particular place.

3. During the last three years of service of an officer, efforts will be made to give him a posting of his choice to the extend possible.

4. Officers who refuse promotion on transfer to places outside the places of their pasting will be debarred for promotion for a period of six months from the date of order of transfer, In the event of their refusing promotion on transfer sub-sequeiatly to an outside station they will be deemed to have been debarred till the next D.P.C. panel is prepared.

5. Media Heads are authorised to transfer Grade-IV and Grad=-Hl and Grade-11 officers within their Media Units.
