Stockpiling ot controlled and uncontrolled cloth in Eastern region

683. SHRI GURUDAS DAS GUPTA: Will the Minister of SUPPLY AND TEX-TILES be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that stocks of both controlled and uncontrolled cloth are piling up in the National Textile Corporation managed mills in the Eastern region;

(b) if sc, what are the details thereof during the last three years and what steps are being taken by Government to clear the stocks;

(c) whether Government have received any complaint about the sale of controlled and uncontrolled cloth to fictitious customers if so, what are the details thereof; and

(d) what amount of money remains unrealised on account of such sale?

THE MINISTER OF SUPPLY AND TEXTILES (SHRI CHANDRA SHEKHAR SINGH): (a) No, Sir.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) and (d) Several complaints about *me* of cloth have been received from time to time. However, no sale to fictions customers has come to light and hence the question of money remaining unrealised on this account does not arise.
