725. SHRI R. SAMBASIVA RAO: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government have recently received any representation from the people of Guntur District with regard to the conversion of the Guntur-Mecherla railway line into broadgauge line in order to link it with Bibi Nagar Nadikudi; and

(b) if so, what action Government have taken thereon?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANSI LAL): Yes, Sir.

(b) This conversion is an approved project and will be progressed according to availability of resources.

(b) and (c) No medicines for treatment of patients suffering from the disease is being imported adequate quantity of drugs are available in the country. However 6 lakhs doses of meningococcal vaccine has been imported through WHO and distributed to Institutes/Hospitals for high risk groups as a preventive measures.

Modernisation of thermal power plan

727. SHRI MUKHTIAR SINGH MALIK: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to refer to the reply to Unstarred Question 414 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 20th March, 1985 and state what are the names of power plants in each State likely to be benefitted under the Rs. 500 crores modernisation scheme during the current financial year and during 1986-87 and the extra power likely to be generated as a result thereof during the two years, separately?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARUN NEHRU): The names of the power stations identified under the Centrally sponsored renovation and modernisation scheme are given in the Statement. An amount of Rs. 90 crores has been provided for the scheme in 1985-86. Provision for 1986-87 will be finalised next year. The scheme is expected to be implemented over three years and the benefits will accrue thereafter.

Construction of hospital in trans-Yamuna area in Delhi

728. SHRI F. M. KHAN: Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to construct a hospital in the trans-Yamuna area in Delhi; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof and by when it is likely to be constructed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (SHRI YOGENDRA MAKWANA): (a) and (b) The Government have approved the establishment of one 500 bedded Guru Teg Bahadur Medical College and Hospital at Shahdara and one 100 bedded hospital at Khichripur in trans-Yamuna area in Delhi. The hospitals will be commissioned during the current Five Year Plan.

Execution of approved power projects

729. SHRI KRISHNA KUMAR BIRLA: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

(a) what are the approved power projects which are yet to be taken up

for execution and the States in which these projects are to be taken up;

(b) when these projects were approved and what is the schedule of their completion;

(c) what are the reasons for delay in taking up these projects; and

(d) what is the extent of cost escalation as a result of delay in their completion and what steps are contemplated by Government to take up these projects for execution and also to ensure their completion within the stipulated period to avoid further cost escalation?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF POWER (SHRI ARUN NEHRU): (a) to (c) The information is given in the Statement-I and II attached.

(d) The cost escalation and overall delay in the projects would be known when the works are commenced at the projects. Impediments in commencement of works are being monitored by Central Electricity Authority/Department of Power and help is being given for removal of bottlenecks to commence the work.
