Lift irrigation in Madhya Pradesh

807. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

(a) the allocation proposed by the Central Government for aiding the development and agumenting of lift irrigation projects in Madhya Pradesh during the Seventh Five Year Plan period; and

(b) whether the Central Government have given any directive to the Madhya Pradesh Government to increase the area under irrigation, if so, the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B. SHANKA-RANAND): (a) and (b) Irrigation is a State subject and irrigation projects are planned, funded and implemented by the State Governments themselves. Central assistance is given in the form of block-loans and block grants and is not tied to any particular scheme or sector of development. With a view to increase the area under irrigation, the State Governments have been urged to accord priority to completion of ongoing projects in advanced stage by allocating adequate funds.

Kelo Irrigation Project

808. SHRI SURESH PACHOURI: Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

(a) whether there is any proposal under Government's consideration to execute Kelo Irrigation Project in Madhya Pradesh; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B. SHANKA-RANAND): (a) There is no such proposal under the consideration of Government.

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI MADHAVRAO SCINDIA): (a) Number of train accidents which took place during March and April, 1985 and the number of persons killed and injured in these accidents are as under:

Number of train accidents .. 143

Number of persons killed .. 43

Number of persons injured.. 210
