**Projects and the Governing Body of Indian Council of Social Science Research**

821. SHRI M. BASAVARAJU;

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

(a) when the present governing body of the Indian Council of Social Science Research was constituted;

(b) by when the said body is likely to be reconstituted;

(c) the projects undertaken by the I.C.S.S.R. during the last three years together with amounts involved in each project; and

(d) the number of projects completed so far?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) and (b) The Indian Council of Science Research consists of a Chairman, 15 Social Scientists and 6 Government representatives nominated by the Government of India and the Member-Secretary. The term of office of members is three years. The present Chairman was appointed with effect from 21st July, 1983. 18 Social Scientists are so nominated that the term of one-third of them expires on 31st March every year. -When the term of office of a member comes to an end, the vacancy is filled by Government through nomination. Steps are being taken to nominate six Social Scientists and one Government representative against seven vacancies which occurred on 31st March, 1985.

(c) The Council does not ordinarily undertake research projects on its own. It sponsors and provides financial support to individual research in social sciences. During the last three years the Council provided financial support for 258 projects. The amount sanctioned for each project varied from Rs. 2,200 to Rs. 2,40,000 depending upon the nature and duration of the project.

(d) Completion reports in respect of 41 projects out of 109 for which the completion reports were due on 31st March, 1985, have been received by the Council.
