(b) The AU India Coordinated Research Project on Cattle is at present located at the Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar, Haryana Agricultural University, Hissar, Jawahar Lal Nehru Krishi Vishwa Vidyalaya, Jabalpur, Mahatma Priule Krishi Vidya Peeth, Rahuri and Andhra Pradesh Agricultural University, Lam. The targets were set for production of different halfbred and 3/4 crossbred genetic groups and testing their performance, which have been achieved at all the centres within the limitation of the infrastructural facilities available. Since it is a long term project for evolving new breed (s) of cows suitable for different agroecological conditions, no yearwise targets have been fixed or achievements assessed.
