approved a project of Hindustan Teleprinters Limited (HTL), Madras, a Public Sector Undertaking under the Ministry of Communications for manufacture of 8000 numbers Electronic Teleprinters per annum, at estimated cost of Rs. 5 crores including a foreign exchange component of Rs. 2.36 crores. HTL have signed a collaboration Agreement for transfer of technology for manufacture electronic teleprinters with SAGEM of France. The ultimate capacity of manufacture of 8000 numbers is expected to be achieved by the end of fourth year of production. The Agreement shall be valid for a period of 10 years from the effective date.

- (a) whether it is a fact that medical experts appointed by the Steering Committee constituted by his Ministry did not draw up the list of 95 drugs for price control and recommended other drugs for price control, if so, how the National Drugs and Pharmaceutical Development Council based their decision to price control only 95 bulk drugs on their recommendations;
- (b) whether it is a fact that essential medicines such as Thiopentone Sodium, Baralgon Keton, Analgin, Dextropropoxyphene, Phendozocaine, Tetramisol, Pyrantel, Intestophene, Tinidazole, Adviamycin and

many other life saving drugs have not been included in price control list and if so, what were the basis and whether the effect of such a decision was studied and if so, what are the details thereof; and

(c) what is the annual sales turnover of each therapeutic group covered under present price control and what is the percentage of each items recommended for price control?

THE MINISTER OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEER-ENDRA PATIL): (a) and (b) Sir. The Medical experts who were Members of the Steering Committee of the National Drug and Pharmace-Development Council utical draw up a list of 95 priority drugs. The medicines required by the large majority of people for the most common diseases known including those required by the National Health Programmes constituted the Thiopentone Sodium, Baralgon Analgin, Dextroproyphene; Phendozocaine, Tetramisol. Pyrantel, Intestophene, Tinidazole, Adviamycin do not figure in the list of 95 priority drugs.

(c) Over 70 per cent of the bulk drugs and formulations produced in the country are now subject to price control. Details of annual sales turnover of present therapeutic groups under price control and the percentage of annual sales turnover of priority list of drugs to the aforesaid percentages are not available.
