(c) Under the special powers vested in the Vice-Chancellor by Section 19(3) of the Aligarh Muslim University Act, 1981, appointments were made to 306 teaching and 64 non-teaching posts.

Review of the Indian Railways Act

1517. DR. MOHD. HASHIM KID. WAI: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government are considering any proposal to review the Indian Railways Act; and

(b) if so, what are the details thereof?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANSI LAL): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) The review of the existing Indian Railways Act is under process in consultation with the Ministry of Law & Justice for replacement of this Act by a comprehensive legislation. Since the review is still under process, it would be premature to give the details of the proposal at this stage.

Development of Trilingual Computerised Typewriters

(a) whether Government are aware of the trilingual computerised typewriter developed by the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras; and

(b) whether incentives are proposed to be provided to develop this typewriter for use in English and Hindi in Central Government offices?

THE MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI K. C. PANT): (a) and (b) The Scientists at Indian Institute of Technology, Madras have developed a trilingual (Tamil English Hindi) computer system with colour display. The equipment will be used by Madras Doordarshan from June, 1985. There is at present no proposal for its use in other offices.
