These amounts include value of deposits in different banks, societies and companies.

The evidence collected through the examination of bank accounts has been cited at appropriate places to corroborate other revelations made by the concerned accused persons.

Visit of Foreign Football Teams

1748. SHRIMATI KRISHNA KAUL: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Sports Authority of India recently sponsored the visit of a mediocre football team from China, if so, what are the reasons therefor; and

(b) the criteria adopted for sponsoring visit of foreign football teams?
