Out of the total Central assistance allocable to the States, the requirement of the eight special category States which are all backward is first preempted. The balance is allocated to the nonspecial category States under fhe modified Gadgil formula which, inter-alia, assigns 20 per cent weightage

to the States, such as Uttar Pradesh, having p_{er} capita income below the national average. Besides, special market borrowings are also made available to backward States such as Uttar Pradesh having per capita income below the national average.
