THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF STEEL (SHRI K. NATWAR SINGH): (a) As on 21st April 1985 SAIL, had a stock of 588,400 tonnes (provisional) of steel.

(b) It is expected that SAIL is likely to make a modest profit in 1984-85, the exact amount will b_e known after the accounts are finalised.

Under th> branch licensing policy for the period April 1982 to March 1985, Hilly Regions, regions sparsely populated r.nd tribal areas were given special consideration and branch expansion in such areas was allowed on a comparatively liberal basis. The branch expansion policy for the Seventh Five Year Plan period has not yet been finalised.
