

THE MINISTER OF STEEL, MINES AND COAL (SHRI VASANT SATHE):

(a) The Review Committee on Indian Bureau of Mines made 54 recommendations. Government approved the overall objectives relating to the strengthening of the Bureau, organisational set up, etc., and decided that recommendations involving large additional inputs may be considered for implementation in a staggered manner, on the basis of plans to be prepared by the Bureau. Many of the recommendations have been implemented and some are under various stages of consideration.

(c) The matter has been referred to the Pay Commission.

D.A. increase for employees of public sector undertakings

166. SHRI S.W. DHABE: Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the staff and workmen employed in public sector undertakings has been revised by Government recently;

(b) if so, what are the enhanced rates of Dearness Allowance; and

(c) what is the basis for fixing this rate?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI JANARDHAN POOJARI): (a) Yes, Sir.

(b) With effect from 1.4.83 the Industrial D.A. rate has been enhanced from Rs. 1.30 to Rs. 1.65 per point shift in AICPI (Simla Series 1960-100) beyond AICPI-492.

(c) The rate has been arrived at on the basis of the report of the Tripartite DA Committee and Consensus evolved as a result of further consultations the Government had with the representatives of Central Trade Union Organisations.
