THE MINISTER OF STATE THE MINISTRY OF INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING (SHRI V. N. GADGIL): (a) Doordarshan TV Programmes relayed from the Low Power Transmitter at Aizwal do not reach Lunglei in South Mizoram.

- (b) The approved Plan for Expansion of TV service in the Northincludes Eastern Region establishment of a 1 KW Transmitter Programme Production Facilities Aizwal. This Plan which is under implementation, does not include a transmitter at Lunglei.

Group has suggested that (a) required degree of priority in investment should be given to these programmes ensuring the integration of such investment with the relevant sectoral development programme in areas, (b) better planning and monitoring of the programmes should ensured through tighter organisation and effective implementation. (c) suitable backward and forward linkages should be provided to enable the beneficiaries to derive optimum benefits from the assistance provided to them.
