(a) whether it is a fact that under the modified Master Plan for Delhi, only essential Central Government offices will be located in Delhi; and

(b) if so, what are the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI ABDUL GHAFOOR):

(a) and (b) Perspective Development Plan-Delhi, 2001 prepared by the Delhi Development Authority proposes a restrictive policy on employment generation and location of Government offices in Delhi to check the rapid population growth of Delhi Metropolis.

The actual provision under these programmes upto the end of the current year is likely to be Rs. 2370.95 crores (including State share under N.R.E.P.):
