

(c) whether it is a fact that the U.K. and the Pakistan Governments are giving all help to these extremists; and

(d) if the replies to parts (a) and (b) above be in the affirmative what steps Government have taken in this regard?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI KHURSHID ALAM KHAN): (a), (b) and (d) Reports about the undesirable activities of extremist elements have come to the notice of the Government, Strict vigilance is being maintained in this regard by the authorities.

(c) The attitude of these Governments in this regard is unsatisfactory.

Situation in the North Eastern Region

1271. SHRI PUTTAPAGA RADHA-KRISHNA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that like Punjab, North Eastern region continues to be in turmoil as reported in the News Time of the 24th February, 1985; and

(b) if so, what remedial steps the Government propose to take to normalise the situation in these special ethnic regions?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRIMATI RAM DULARI SINHA): (a) Government's attention has been drawn to the news item. However, the Government does not agree with the facts as mentioned in the news item. The situation in Manipur, Mizoram and Nagaland has generally remained under control while there has been some increase in the activities of the extremists in Tripura.

(b) Security measures have been tightened. Combing operations in the affected areas have been taken up and strict vigil is being maintained. The strength of Central security forces where necessary has also been augmented. So far as bor-

der of Nagaland-Assam is concerned, State Governments have been advised to exercise restraint and settle the disputes peacefully.

Plight of women prisoners in India

1272. SHRI PUTTAPAGA RADHA-KRISHNA: Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news report which appeared in certain sections of the press on harassment, torture, rape etc., of women prisoners in jails in India as brought out by Amnesty International high-lighting examples of Bihar and Mathura jails; and

(b) if so what remedial steps the Central Government have taken or propose to take to ensure that women all over India are free from these indignities?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS

(SHRIMATI RAM DULARI SINHA): (a) and (b) Government are not aware

of any such reports in the Press. Further the latest Report of the Amnesty International for 1984 covering the period January to December 1983 does not refer to any such incidents. In order that women in custody do not suffer any indignity, the need for reorienting the approach and behaviour of the custodial staff towards them has been emphasised upon the State Governments from time to time

Government jobs?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE
MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL AND
TRAINING, ADMINISTRATIVE RE-
FORMS AND PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND
PENSION AND DEPARTMENT OF
CULTURE (SHRI K. P. SINGH DEO): There
is yet no proposal under consideration to
prescribe 10 plus 2 as the minimum
qualification for the Central Government
jobs.

Allotment of land by IAAI to private firms for Construction of Hotels/Beautifications

1275. SHRI BHAGATRAM MAN-
HAR: Will the PRIME MINISTER be
pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the inter-
national Airports Authority of India has
allotted land adjoining to their hotel under
construction in Bombay to the Leela Penta
Hotels for construction/beautification;

(b) if so, on what terms and conditions;

(c) whether it is also a fact that some
other firms have also requested the IAAI for
allotment of land adjoining their plot
proposed for construction of a hotel for the
same purpose;

(d) if so, what are the details thereof;

(e) whether it is a fact that the said
land is being used by unauthorised per-
sons;

(f) if so, whether any action is being taken
against them by Government; and

(g) by when the terms and conditions for
allotment of the said land will be finalised?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE
MINISTRY OF TOURISM AND CIVIL
AVIATION (SHRI ASHOK GEHLOT): (a)
The International Airports Authority of India
has allotted land at Bombay Airport to M/s
Leela Penta Hotels for construction of a hotel
and flight kitchen, including beautification.
The allotted land is, however, not adjoining
any IAAI hotel under construction.

(b) An area of 18,000 Sq. mtrs. has been
allotted on lease for a period of 30 years and
another 11,000 Sq. mtrs. on licence basis for a
period of 5 years. The current rate of lease
rent/licence fee, is Rs 25/- per Sq mtr. per
annum. In addition, the Company is required
to pay 4 per cent of its gross turnover from the
hotel and flight kitchen. The lease rent is
subject to revision every three years.

(c) and (d) Yes, Sir. A private Company
named M/s. Anmol Properties (Pvt.) Limited
have requested for allotment of about 22,000
Sq. mtrs. of land adjoining the plot allotted to
M/s. Leela Penta Hotels for construction of a
hotel.

(e) Apart of this land is under un-
authorised occupation.

(f) Appropriate action has been initiated
to remove the encroachments.

(g) Since allotment of land for another
hotel is not being considered for the present,
the question of finalising the terms and
conditions does not arise.

Posts of Inspectors in the Directorate of Welfare for SC/ST. Delhi Administration

(a) whether it is a fact that for the posts of
inspectors in the Directorate of
