Threat to Lion Sanctuaries

1265. PROF. C. LAKSHMANNA: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government's attention has been drawn to the news report which) appeared in the Times of India of the 11th February, 1985 regarding threat to three lion sanctuaries in the country;
- (b) if so, the redressal measures proposed to be taken by Government in this regard;
- (c) whether it is a fact that the Gir Sanctuary is also under destruction; if so, the remedial steps taken in this regard; and
- (d) whether it is also a fact that Government have dropped the plans for the Silent Valley Project only for the time being and not permanently as per the wishes of the late Prime Minister Shrimati Indira Gandhi?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI VIR SEN): (a) to .(c) The New Delhi edition of the Times of India dated llth February, 1985 does not contain any news report regarding threat to lion sanctuaries in the country. There is only one sanctuary and national park in the country which has lions and that is the Gir National Park and Sanctuary in Gujarat. The State Government of Gujarat whoare responsible for the management of the Park and Sanctuary have been advised from time to time to take all possible steps to preserve the eco-system of Gir Sanctuary/National Park.

(d) The Stote Government of Kerala has finally notified the entire Silent Valley Reserve Forest as a National Park with effect from 15th November, 1984.

Impounding of passports by Missions abroad

1266. SHRI KHUSHWANT SINGH: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there are any specific rules under which Indian officials in missions abroad are entitled to impound passports of Indian citizens;
- (b) whether it is a fact that passport of Shri Khalid Sabh-, General Secretary of the World Muslim Minority Commission has been impounded by the Indian High Commission in London; and
 - (c) if so, the reasons therefor?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI KHURSHID ALAM KHAN): (a) Yes, Sir. All passport Issuing Authorities in India and in our diplomatic missions abroad derive the powers to issue, refuse, impound or revoke passports from the Passports Act. 1967.

- (b) Yes, Sir.
- <c) The activities of Shri Khalid Sabir son of Shri Ghulam .Sabir were considered to be prejudicial to the interests of the sovereignty and integrity of India and the security of India, and hence attracted Section 10(3) (c) of the Passports Act, 1967. His Passport was accordingly impounded under this section.</p>

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS (SHRI KHURSHID ALAM KHAN): (a) Government of India is not aware of any such proposal by the Tamil Nadu Government.

Setting up of Central administrative tribunal for Central Government employees

(a) whether Government have set up a Central Administrative Tribunal for the

Central Government employees as envisaged in the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985: and

(b) if so, the names of the Central Government departments including independent offices which are not covered under this Tribunal?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF PERSONNEL AND TRAINING, ADMINISTRATIVE FORMS AND PUBLIC GRIEVANCES AND PENSION AND DEPARTMENT OF THE CULTURE (SHRI K. P. SINGH DEO): (a) Action to set up the Central Administrative Tribunal has been initiated.

- (b) The Central Administrative Tribunal when esiablirhid will not have any jurisdiction over th; following:
- (i) any member of the naval, military or air forces or of any other armed forces of the Union;
 - (iil any person governed by the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. in regard to such matters in respect of which he is so governed;
 - (iii) any officer or servant of the Supreme Court or of any High Court;
 - (iv) any person appointed to the secretarial staff of either House of Parliament or in the case of a Union Territory having a Legislature, of that Legislature.

Support to extremists by the British and **Pak Governments**

1270. SHRI RAMANAND YADAV: Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government are aware of the fact that Sikh and Jammu and Kashmir extremists have planned joint action agaist Indian leaders to kill and spread terrorist activities in India as reported in Times of India of the 6th March 1985;
- (b) whether Government are aware that they have made their headquarters in London and Lahore to coordinate with counterpart extremist in India?
