

(b) and (c) The Government of Kerala initially sought Central assistance of Rs. 158.68 crores in their first Memorandum. Subsequently, in their supplementary memorandum, they increased the amount to Rs. 195.15 crores. The matter was examined by the Central Team and the High Level Committee. On their recommendation, a ceiling of Central assistance of Rs. 21.33 crores was sanctioned to the State for flood relief. After issue of this sanction, the State Government again came up for Central assistance for additional amount. This was examined and the request was not agreed to.
