

आगे छे जाये गये स्टक सहित उक्त अधिकांश उत्पादन और चालू वर्ष के उत्पादन का एक भाग 1984-85 में वितरित किया गया था ।

(ग) अनुमान है कि 1984-85 के दौरान अधिक उपज देने वाली किस्मों के लगभग 18.05 लाख क्विंटल प्रमाणीत/अच्छी किस्म के गेहूं के बीज वितरित किये गये । अपने किसानों की मांग को पूरा करने के पश्चात् फालतु बीज में से लगभग 71,000 क्विंटल बीज नेपाल, बंगलादेश और यमन को निर्यात किया गया ।

#### D.D.A. Housing scheme for retired employees

13. SHRI JAGADAMBI PRASAD YADAV: Will the Minister of WORKS AND HOUSING be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the construction of flats for retired employees under D.D.A.'s Scheme, 1982, has not been started so far;

(b) if so, what are the reasons for the delay and by when construction is likely to start; and

(c) what is the proposed site where the construction is to be started and the time by when applications for allocation, allotment of flats from the registered persons are likely to be invited?

THE MINISTER OF WORKS AND HOUSING (SHRI ABDUL GAFOOR):

(a) A special General Housing Scheme for retired/retiring public servants was opened between 15.12.1982 to 15.2.1983 and those Government servants who had retired within the period of three years from the date of scheme or were to retire within a period of 3 years from that date were eligible for registration. As per record a total number of 3440 persons i.e. 1428 in MIG, 1744 in LIG and 268 in Janta were registered under the scheme.

(b) No specific construction of flats for the retired employees has been undertaken but the registrants under the scheme will now be allotted flats out of 5,000 unallotted Janta, LIG and MIG flats likely to be ready for possession between March and December, 1985.

(c) These flats are located in Pashim Puri, Pitampura and Rohini in North Delhi, Janak Puri, Vikas Puri, in West Delhi and Dilshad Garden, Trilok Puri and Nand Nagri in East Delhi.

#### Incentives for increasing sugar production

14. SHRI KRISHNA KUMAR BIRLA: Will the Minister of FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES be pleased to state what incentives are being proposed to be given to sugar factories so that the production of sugar could be increased?

THE MINISTER OF FOOD AND CIVIL SUPPLIES (RAO BIRENDRA SINGH): In order to maximise sugar production Government have in the past given incentives to sugar factories in the shape of an incentive scheme for high cost new sugar factories as well as existing factories undertaking substantial expansion. In addition, the fixation of a proper level of statutory minimum sugarcane price, leading to the fixation of a reasonable levy price and the grant of an incremental levy price to weak units on account of the age and lower capacity had been given. Some of these incentives are also being thought of for the current sugar year 1984-85, as also State Governments have been advised to control diversion of sugarcane from factories' reserved areas to khandasaries and power crushers making gur.

#### Modernisation of Sone Canal System

(a) whether it is a fact that the Sone Canal System (Bihar) has become out of date;
