**Losses due to cyclone in Andhra Pradesh AND Tamil Nadu**

24. SHRI F. M. KHAN: Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) the estimated loss of life, crops and property due to the recent cyclonic storm and heavy rains in Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu; and

(b) the details of the compensation relief given by Government to the victims so far?

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI BUTA SINGH): (a) As per information received from the States of Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu, the estimated loss

of life and property due to cyclone and heavy rains are as under:

(iii) Human lives lost	625	59

(b) The reports from the Central Teams, which visited Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu for an on-the-spot assessment of the situation is under processing. Pending the sanction of ceiling of Central assistance, a ways and means advance of Rs. 17.00 crores to Andhra Pradesh and Rs. 5.00 crores to Tamil Nadu have already been released for meeting emergent expenditure.

**Electrification of Villages in Madhya Pradesh**

25. SHRIMATI RATAN KUMARI: Will the MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state

(a) the number of villages in Madhya Pradesh yet to be electrified;

(b) the target fixed for electrification of such villages in the State; and

(c) the time by when the villages in Madhya Pradesh are likely to be electrified?

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) Out of a total of 70,883 census villages in Madhya Pradesh, 39,172 villages have been electrified till the end of December, 1984, leaving a balance of 31,711 villages remaining to be covered.

(b) and (c) By the end of the Sixth plan, the total number of villages electrified in the State is expected to be about 39,800. As per the programme formulated by the State Electricity Board, 19,300 additional villages are proposed to be electrified during the Seventh Plan period. Hundred per cent electrification of villages in Madhya Pradesh is, therefore,
