DGTD Registrations have been granted and 25 Industrial Licence applications and 112 DGTD Registration applications have been rejected I closed owing to the reasons such as inadequate information, proposals n6t satisfying drug policy parameters, enough capacity being already approved, location being not permissible etc. Out of "the applications received during the period 1-1-84 to 31-12-84, 16 Industrial Licence applications and 34 DGTD Registration applications are under various stages of consideration.

Increase in the Prices of Bulk Drugs

123. SHRIMATI MAIMOONA SULTAN: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) what are the names of the bulk drugs and formulations for which Ihe prices have been increased after January, 1984;
- (b) what is the percentage increase and whether it is a fact that these increases have been worked out indiscriminately and if so, what are the details of the cases where existing notified norms and parameters have not been followed;
- (c) what arrangements have been made to scrutinise formulation prices •by his Ministry;

- (d) whether it is a fact that proper verification of prices, quantities of pharmaceutical aids and other raw materials is not being done by the Bureau of Industrial Costs and Prices and due to that certain companies are getting high prices; and
- (e) if so, what steps Government have taken in this direction?

THE MINISTER OF CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS (SHRI VEERENDRA PATTL): (a) and (b) Since January, 1984, the prices of 17 bulk drugs and 47 packs of leader formulations have been increased and those of 9 Bulk Drugs and 29 packs of leader formulations have been decreased. The percentage increase in prices in cases of upward revision is shown. in the attached Statement.

(c) and (d) Bureau of Industrial Costs and Prices make necessary verifications of Bills and Invoices in respect of all bulk drugs, pharmaceutical aids and packing materials before recommending formulation prices to my Ministry. Ministry of Industry has constituted an inter-Ministerial Drug Prices Review Committee. The Sub-Committee of the Drugs Prices Review Committee recommends the formulation prices to my Ministry after approval of the prices by the Chairman Bureau of Industrial Cost* and PricesjDrugs Prices Review Committee.
