- (2) Instructions have been given to trade particularly Public Sector Undertakings and Government Organisations to normany concluded contracts for handles on FOB basis and exports on C & F basis which would ensure control of shipping arrangements with importers/exporters in India so that Indian ships could be utilised to the maximum extent. Exceptions are to be made only in consultation with Ministry of Shipping & Transport.
- (3) Position regarding utilisation of Indian ships is periodically viewed by a Standing Committee consisting of representatives concerned Government departments and Public Sector Undertakings.
- (4) Government have decided that:
- (i) the freight paid shall not be debited to the face value of import licence if the ocean freight is paid in non-convertible rupee in India and the goods are carried on Indian vessels; and
 - (ii) the exporters will be given R E.P. licence on exports in question at the rate of 11 per cent as against normal rate of 10 per cant if the goods are exported on Indian vessels.
