(c) whether the Central Government have any control over such negotiations and agreements?

THE MINISTER OF STATE OF THE MINISTRY OF SOCIAL AND WOMEN'S WELFARE (SHRIMATI MARAGATHAM CHANDRASE-

KHAR): (a) Yes, Sir. The expected commodity assistance valued at \$ 105 million relates to US fiscal _{ve}ar 1985 (1 October, 1984 to 30 September 1985).

- (b) Food commodities are being provided through three voluntary agencies—CARE (Cooperative for American -Relief Everywhere). CRS Catholic Relief Services), and CLUSA (Cooperative League of USA). The break-up is approximately: CARE \$ 66 million; CRS \$ 28 million; and CLUSA \$ 11 million.
 - (c) Yes, Sir.

Proposed Karur-Dmdigul Tuticorin j Railway Line

*80. SHRI M. KADHARSHA: SHRI M. S. RAMACHANDRAN:

Will tne Minister of RAILWAYS j be pleased to state:

- (a) what is the progress made so) far in the conversion as well as new-construction of the proposed Karur-Dindigul-Tuticorin Railway Line;
- (b) whether it is a fact that paucity of funds stands in the way of speedy completion of the project; and
- (c) by when the project is likely to be completed?

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI SCINDIA): MADHAVRAO (a) The progress of construction of a parallel Broad Gauge line between Tirunel-veli and Tuticorin Maniyachchi 60 Kms.) is 48 per cent, while work of construction of the new line has also been started from end j and progress between Karur and Dindigul (72.90 Kms.) is 6 per cent. In addition, the work on construction of a major bridge over Vaigai river (between Dindigul and Madu-rai) is also in progress.

- (b) Yes, Sir. The outlay for this project during 1984-85 is however, substantial.
- (c) No target date for the comple tion of this 324 Kms. project has been fixed so far.

Chata Pathar fly-over at Asansol

- 236. SHP.I DIPEN GHOSH: Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state;
- (a) by when the Chata Pathar flyover at Asansol is likely to be completed;
 - (b) what is its present position; and
- (c) what are the reasons for the delay in its completion?

THE MINISTER OF RAILWAYS (SHRI BANSI LAL): (a) Chata Pathar fly-over is expected to be completed by June, 1985.

- (b) The abutments at both the ends have been completed. The work on girders is in progress.
- (c) There has been a minor delay due to using pre-cast girders instead of cast-in-situ girders to avoid detentions to rail traffic on this busy electrified route.

Drinking Water at Howrah Railway Station
