THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) and (b) According to the Department of Mines, an agreement entitled "UK/India BALCO Power Project Aid Arrangement 1984" was signed on 20.9.1984 between Government of India & Government of United Kingdom allocating £131 million as UK aid for financing the setting up of a 4X67.5 MW coal based captive power plant at Korba for the Aluminium Complex of BALCO. Of the total aid of £ 131 million, £ 94 million shall be utilised for financing the supply and erection of plant and equipment from U.K. and £ 37 million to meet the related local costs.

Re-organisation of Central Ground Water Board

557. **SHRI R. SAMBASIVA RAO:** Will the Minister of IRRIGATION AND POWER be pleased to state:

THE MINISTER OF IRRIGATION AND POWER (SHRI B. SHANKARANAND): (a) and (b) To achieve the targets of coverage of the entire hydrogeological survey work by 1990 and exploratory drilling by 1995 and diversify its activities and modernise the organisation, a proposal for reorganisation of Central Ground Water Board has been approved in principle.

The proposal envisages creation of six additional regional directorates, four circle offices, four engineering divisions, two zonal offices and five Special studies Directorates for Map Production and Publication; Mathematical modelling, data storage; Remote Sensing and Ground Water Pollution, besides upgradation of the posts of Chief Hydrogeologist, Chief Engineer and Chairman, Central Ground Water Board.
