Central Government to the adverse effects on the trade, commerce and industry in Kashmir caused often by the blockade of National Highwoy No. IA and cancellation of flights to and from Srinagar. Ours is a long table of sorrow and sufferings and the apathy of the powers that be adds manifold dimension to them. The National Highway IA, the only lifeline linking the valley to the rest of the country, is directly maintained by the Border Roads Organisation under the Ministry of Shipping and Transport. Time without number it gets blocked mainly from Udhampur to Qazigund for days together especially during winter due to landslides, heavy snowfall, rain and avalanches. This road, I have a number of times explained, lacks proper and adequate maintenance so that snow clearing machines are either not in working condition or are not available in substantial number. The landslide at Nashri has won its own notoriety so much so that there is no road there whenever there is con-: tinuous rain even in summer and the bypass-a very narrow road too steep and full of risks is very long-consuming about five hours for a heavy vehicle to ply on. Imagine the fate of passengers whose vehicle is abruptly stopped on this road due to blockade. The passengers shiver in unbearable cold with no food and other eatables, absolutely cut of? from all sorts of communication system, helplessly and hopelessly. The fate of the sheep and poultry in stranded trucks is worse as they die of hunger and thirst on this road. The common man in Kashmir faces acute shortage, even total non-availability, of essential commodities, giving a chance to the blackmarketeers to hoard and exploit the situation. Fruit. the main export of Kashmir, gets damaged due to frost, snow and rain. This sorry state of affairs gets worse when Indian Airlines cancels its flights to and from Srinagar. The reason given is that the Srinagar Airport lacks proper equinment for snow clearance and landing faciliies to the planes in

low visibility. The people in the valley mostly depend on tourism industry and the ball maintenance of National Highway IA and frequent cancellations of flights to and from Srinugar have caused irrepnirable lose to thin industry.
