

Cape Verde; the Secretary-General of the Commonwealth; the Secretary-General of UNCTAD; the Secretary-General of OECD and Mr. Willy Brandt, the Chairman of the Independent Commission on International Development Issues.

The Conference adopted a Declaration calling for "a new opening in the North-South Dialogue" and a concerted European effort to break the present deadlock in global negotiations. It asked European countries to support a world conference on the reform of the international financial and monetary system and proposed the establishment of a special working group of high level experts from the North and the South to prepare proposals to be submitted to the Conference. It also asked European countries to make a joint effort to "reverse the US decision to limit its annual contribution to IDA VII to Dollar 750 million (corresponding to a total of Dollar 9 billion for 3 years') and, in any case, to undertake a collective effort to provide IDA with a total replenishment of Dollar 12 billion. Other specific measures proposed in the Declaration include increase in European contributions to multilateral agencies, attainment of the target of 0.7 per cent of GNP for Official Development Assistance increase in the resources of IMF and World Bank, the reversal of protectionist trends and the speedy implementation of the Integrated Programme for Commodities and the Common Fund.

#### **Unfiltered water**

(a) whether it is a fact that there is and acute shortage of unfiltered (hydrant) water in the Teen Murti Lane, New Delhi area;

THE DEPUTY MINISTER IN THE DEPARTMENT OF SPORTS AND IN THE MINISTRY OF WORKS AND HOUSING AND IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI MALLIKARJUN): (a) Shortage of unfiltered water does occur sometimes in Teen Murti Lane during summer season.

(b) Yes.

(c) Attempts are being made to improve the situation by putting a new six inch CI pipe line for part of the unfiltered water supply system.

#### **Holding of Parliament Session in South India**
