**Production of Films for India by the Foreign Television Network**

**Price of Sulphamoxole**

983. SHRIMATI MAIMOONA SULTAN: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to refer to the answer 10 Starred Question 113 given in the Rajya Sabha on the 5th March, 1984 and state:

(a) the reasons for not reducing the price of Sulphamoxole after 1982 particularly when the production of the drug has substantially gone up;

(b) the value of imported and indigenous raw materials used for the production of this drug, source of each raw material, quantity produced during the last three years, year-wise, and the price paid;

(c) the steps that have been contemplated to reduce the price of Sulphamoxole;

(d) the names of various raw materials importer by the company directly or indirectly during the last three years, year-wise, with details of quantity imported, CIF price paid and source of import; and

(e) the leading formulations available in the market based on this bulk drug including their prices and sales turnover of each during last two years, year-wise?
