Drugs manufactured by M/s Glaxo Labs

995. SHRI RAM BHAGAT PASWAN: Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

(a) what are the names of all the drugs manufactured by M/s. Glaxo Labs, and names out of them which are manufactured from basic stages particularly vitamins and synthetic drugs in general;

(b) whether post-manufacturing expenses on their products have been calculated; and

(c) if so, what are the details thereof?

Glaxo Laboratories had manufactured bulk drugs; namely Betamethasone and its salts, Hydrocortisone Acetate/Hemisuccinate, Methioilazine HCl, Vitamin A, Meclozine HCl, Chlor-phenesin, Megestrol Acetate, Calcium Sennocides, Trichloroethyl Phosphate and Vaccines. Out of these drugs the company had manufactured Bethamethasone, Vitamin A, Mephensin, Calcium Sennocides, Trichloroethyl Phosphate and Vaccines from basic stage.
