- (b) All the pit heads are not linked by rail and it is for the Coal Companies to transport coal from pitheads to railheads and arrange its loading. Further, the railways have transported about 5 million tonnes more coal during 1983-84 as compared to 1982-83 despite an increase in the number of wagon left-behind and drawn empty from 1587 wagons per day during 1982-83 to 1692 wagons per day during 1983-84.
- (c) Information regarding supply of wagons for loading coal is not maintained coal company-wise by the Rail-ways.
- (d) No. The coal companies have paid demurrage charges amounting to Rs. 1.73 crores from 1-4-1983 to 29-2-1984 and bills for another 9.73 crores are pending settlement.
 - (e) Does not arise.
